

TERMS & CONDITIONS

Multi-Day Hiking Event & Basecamp Event

1. Organizer

The event is organized by **Jack Wolfskin Ausrüstung für Draussen GmbH & Co. KGaA**, Jack Wolfskin Kreisel 1, 65510 Idstein (hereinafter referred to as "Jack Wolfskin" or "Organizer").

These Terms & Conditions govern participation in the guided multi-day hiking event as well as attendance at the open event on May 16. The events are organized by Jack Wolfskin (hereinafter referred to as "JW" or "Organizer"). By registering for the multi-day hike or attending the open event, participants agree to be bound by these Terms & Conditions.

PART A – MULTI-DAY GUIDED HIKE (Limited to 25 Participants)

2. Registration and Eligibility

Participation in the multi-day hike is limited to 25 registered participants. Registration becomes binding upon confirmation by Jack Wolfskin. Participants must be at least 18 years of age.

Each participant confirms that they are physically and mentally capable of completing a multi-day hiking tour under outdoor conditions. Any relevant medical conditions, allergies, or physical limitations must be disclosed prior to the event. Jack Wolfskin reserves the right to exclude participants from the event if participation poses a risk to their own safety or to the safety of the group.

3. Services Provided by the Organizer

Jack Wolfskin will provide a professional hiking guide who accompanies the group for the entire duration of the multi-day hike. Accommodation will be arranged at designated camping grounds, and tents will be provided by Jack Wolfskin.

Furthermore, Jack Wolfskin will provide meals for all registered participants, including breakfast, lunch, and dinner during the hiking event.

The Organizer reserves the right to reasonably modify the route, schedule, accommodation, catering arrangements, or other logistical aspects of the event where necessary due to weather conditions, safety considerations, force majeure, official orders, or other circumstances beyond the Organizer's control. Such modifications shall not constitute grounds for claims, provided they are reasonable and made in good faith.

4. Conduct and Participant Obligations

Participants are required to follow all instructions given by the hiking guide and event staff at all times. This applies particularly to safety-related instructions. Participants undertake to behave in a considerate and respectful manner towards other participants, staff, nature, wildlife, and local regulations.

Each participant is responsible for bringing appropriate clothing and personal equipment suitable for outdoor activities and variable weather conditions. Participants must inform the Organizer immediately of any injury, illness, or unusual condition occurring during the event.

Jack Wolfskin reserves the right to exclude participants who significantly violate safety instructions or whose conduct endangers themselves or others.

5. Assumption of Risk

Participants acknowledge that hiking and camping are outdoor activities involving inherent risks. These risks may include, but are not limited to, uneven terrain, falls, changing weather conditions, wildlife encounters, physical exertion, and limited medical access in remote areas.

By participating in the event, participants voluntarily assume these inherent risks and confirm that they are aware of the physical demands associated with a multi-day hiking tour.

6. Liability

The Organizer shall be liable without limitation in cases of intent (Vorsatz), gross negligence, or injury to life, body, or health caused by the Organizer.

In cases of slight negligence, the Organizer shall only be liable for the breach of essential contractual obligations (cardinal duties). In such cases, liability shall be limited to the foreseeable and typical damages at the time of contract conclusion.

The Organizer shall not be liable for loss, theft, or damage to personal belongings brought by participants unless caused by intent or gross negligence. Furthermore, the Organizer shall not be liable for events caused by force majeure, including but not limited to extreme weather conditions, natural disasters, or official restrictions.

Participants are responsible for ensuring that they have adequate personal insurance coverage, including health insurance, accident insurance, and personal liability insurance.

7. Cancellation and Event Changes

The Organizer reserves the right to cancel or postpone the event in whole or in part if circumstances arise that make the event impossible, unsafe, or economically unreasonable to conduct. This includes but is not limited to severe weather, safety concerns, insufficient participation, or force majeure events.

In such cases, participants will be informed without undue delay. Further claims shall be excluded except in cases of mandatory statutory liability.

PART B – BASECAMP EVENT

1. Nature of the Basecamp Event

Jack Wolfskin will host a local open event featuring an information booth, activities, workshops, music, and food trucks. The open event is generally accessible to the public without prior registration, unless otherwise specified. [Click here](#) to find out when and where the open event is will take place.

The Organizer reserves the right to adjust the program, schedule, or participating vendors at its discretion.

2. Liability for the Open Event

Attendance at the open event is at the participant's own risk. The liability of the Organizer shall be governed by the provisions set out in Part A, Section 6 of these Terms & Conditions.

Food and beverages provided by third-party vendors, such as food trucks, are supplied under the responsibility of the respective vendor. Any claims relating to food quality, allergens, or product liability must be directed to the respective provider.

Parents or legal guardians are responsible for supervising their children throughout the duration of the open event.

3. Photography and Media

During both the multi-day hike and the open event, photographs and video recordings may be taken. These recordings may be used by Jack Wolfskin for marketing, communication, documentation, and public relations purposes, including use on websites, social media platforms, and print materials.

Participants may object to the use of identifiable images by notifying the Organizer in writing prior to or during the event.

11. Data Protection

Personal data collected in connection with event registration and organization will be processed solely for purposes of event management, communication, and safety coordination. Data processing will be carried out in accordance with applicable data protection laws. Further details can be found in our [privacy policy](#).

12. Final Provisions

German law shall apply to these Terms & Conditions. Should any provision of these Terms & Conditions be or become invalid, the validity of the remaining provisions shall remain unaffected. The place of jurisdiction shall be the registered office of Jack Wolfskin, insofar as legally permissible.
