

## **TERMS & CONDITIONS**

### **Multi-Day Hiking Event & Basecamp Event**

#### **1. Organizer**

The event is organized by **Jack Wolfskin Ausrüstung für Draussen GmbH & Co. KGaA**, Jack Wolfskin Kreisel 1, 65510 Idstein (hereinafter referred to as "Jack Wolfskin" or "Organizer").

These Terms & Conditions govern participation in the unguided multi-day hiking event as well as attendance at the open event on May 16. The events are organized by Jack Wolfskin (hereinafter referred to as "JW" or "Organizer"). By registering for the multi-day hike or attending the open event, participants agree to be bound by these Terms & Conditions.

#### **PART A – MULTI-DAY UNGUIDED HIKE (Limited to 25 Participants)**

##### **2. Registration and Eligibility**

Participation in the multi-day unguided hike is limited to 25 registered participants. Registration becomes binding upon confirmation by Jack Wolfskin.

Participants must be at least 18 years of age.

Each participant confirms that they are physically and mentally capable of independently completing a multi-day hiking tour under outdoor and alpine conditions without professional guidance or supervision. Any relevant medical conditions, allergies, or physical limitations must be disclosed prior to the event.

Jack Wolfskin reserves the right to exclude participants from the event if participation poses a risk to their own safety or to others.

##### **3. Scope of Services**

Jack Wolfskin does not act as the organizer of the hiking activity itself.

Jack Wolfskin provides the following services only:

- A suggested multi-day hiking route
- Reserved camping grounds / accommodation for the group
- Tents (if applicable)
- Catering services (breakfast, lunch, and dinner) at designated locations

The daily hiking stages are completed independently and at the participants' own responsibility. No professional hiking guide or supervision will be provided during the hiking stages.

Jack Wolfskin reserves the right to reasonably modify accommodation arrangements, catering services, or logistical aspects of the event where necessary due to weather conditions, safety considerations, force majeure, official orders, or other circumstances beyond its control. Such modifications shall not constitute grounds for claims, provided they are reasonable and made in good faith.

#### **4. Participant Responsibility and Conduct**

Participants undertake to organize and carry out each hiking stage independently and at their own responsibility. This includes, in particular:

- Navigation along the suggested route
- Assessment of weather conditions
- Individual pace planning
- Personal safety decisions

Participants are responsible for bringing appropriate clothing and personal equipment suitable for multi-day outdoor activities and variable weather conditions.

Each participant must immediately seek appropriate assistance in case of injury, illness, or emergency during the hiking stages. Jack Wolfskin does not provide on-route emergency supervision or rescue services.

Participants undertake to behave in a considerate and respectful manner towards other participants, nature, wildlife, and applicable local laws and regulations.

Jack Wolfskin reserves the right to exclude participants from accommodation or catering services if their conduct significantly endangers themselves, others, or the orderly execution of the logistical arrangements.

#### **5. Assumption of Risk**

Participants acknowledge that hiking and camping are outdoor activities involving inherent risks. These risks may include, but are not limited to:

- Uneven or alpine terrain
- Falls and injuries
- Changing weather conditions
- Wildlife encounters
- Physical exertion

- Limited mobile reception or medical access in remote areas

Participants expressly acknowledge that the hiking stages are undertaken without professional guidance and entirely at their own risk.

By participating, each participant voluntarily assumes all inherent risks associated with independently conducting a multi-day hiking tour.

## **6. Liability**

Jack Wolfskin shall be liable without limitation in cases of intent (Vorsatz), gross negligence, or injury to life, body, or health caused by Jack Wolfskin in connection with the services provided (accommodation and catering).

In cases of slight negligence, Jack Wolfskin shall only be liable for the breach of essential contractual obligations (cardinal duties). In such cases, liability shall be limited to the foreseeable and typical damages at the time of contract conclusion.

Jack Wolfskin shall not be liable for incidents, damages, injuries, or losses occurring during the independently conducted hiking stages.

Furthermore, Jack Wolfskin shall not be liable for loss, theft, or damage to personal belongings unless caused by intent or gross negligence.

Liability for events caused by force majeure, including but not limited to extreme weather conditions, natural disasters, or official restrictions, is excluded to the extent permitted by law.

Participants are responsible for ensuring that they have adequate personal insurance coverage, including health insurance, accident insurance, rescue insurance (including mountain rescue where applicable), and personal liability insurance.

## **7. Cancellation and Changes**

Jack Wolfskin reserves the right to cancel or modify the accommodation and catering arrangements if circumstances arise that make execution impossible, unsafe, or economically unreasonable. This includes but is not limited to severe weather, safety concerns, insufficient participation, or force majeure events.

In such cases, participants will be informed without undue delay.

Further claims shall be excluded except in cases of mandatory statutory liability.

## **PART B – BASECAMP EVENT**

### **1. Nature of the Basecamp Event**

Jack Wolfskin will host a local open event featuring an information booth, activities, workshops, music, and food trucks. The open event is generally accessible to the public without prior registration, unless otherwise specified. [Click here](#) to find out when and where the open event is will take place.

The Organizer reserves the right to adjust the program, schedule, or participating vendors at its discretion.

### **2. Liability for the Open Event**

Attendance at the open event is at the participant's own risk. The liability of the Organizer shall be governed by the provisions set out in Part A, Section 6 of these Terms & Conditions.

Food and beverages provided by third-party vendors, such as food trucks, are supplied under the responsibility of the respective vendor. Any claims relating to food quality, allergens, or product liability must be directed to the respective provider.

Parents or legal guardians are responsible for supervising their children throughout the duration of the open event.

### **3. Photography and Media**

During both the multi-day hike and the open event, photographs and video recordings may be taken. These recordings may be used by Jack Wolfskin for marketing, communication, documentation, and public relations purposes, including use on websites, social media platforms, and print materials.

Participants may object to the use of identifiable images by notifying the Organizer in writing prior to or during the event.

### **11. Data Protection**

Personal data collected in connection with event registration and organization will be processed solely for purposes of event management, communication, and safety coordination. Data processing will be carried out in accordance with applicable data protection laws. Further details can be found in our [privacy policy](#).

### **12. Final Provisions**

German law shall apply to these Terms & Conditions. Should any provision of these Terms & Conditions be or become invalid, the validity of the remaining provisions shall remain unaffected. The place of jurisdiction shall be the registered office of Jack Wolfskin, insofar as legally permissible.
